


Welcome to your sampling kit

With this kit you can collect and return the samples needed for your recommended tests.

The results of this STI test will show whether a bacteria or virus is present. It's not a clinical diagnosis of a condition and should not replace advice from your doctor. If you have any symptoms of an STI or concerns regarding your sexual health, you should speak with your GP or visit a local sexual health clinic

Returning your samples

Once you're ready to return your samples, place them along with your completed form back into the kit box.

Close it securely by inserting the two large tabs on the box lid into the slots, pressing down firmly to lock them into place. Apply the clear security seal provided or add tape for extra security.

Return postage is not required, just pop the kit box into any Royal Mail post box. Find your nearest post box by scanning this QR code.

Collecting your urine sample

What you will need



Pouch



Bottle



Transport bag

- Wash your hands and unpack the kit on a clean surface, ideally near a toilet.
- Remove the cap from the bottle and stand nearby on a flat surface.
- Urinate into the urine collection pouch provided.
- 4 Carefully pour your sample into the bottle up to the line shown.
- 5 Tightly secure the cap and secure the bottle in the transport bag.



Collecting your throat swab

What you will need



Throat swab

- Wash your hands and unpack the kit on a clean surface.
- Remove the swab from its tube.

 Avoid laying it down or touching its tip.
- Wipe the tip of the swab around the back of your throat. Swab these five areas:



Put the swab back in the tube and push tightly to close the seal.

Collecting your rectal swab

What you will need




Rectal swab

Helpful tip

Before you collect this sample, it helps to wipe your bottom with a tissue.

- Wash your hands and unpack the kit on a clean surface, ideally in a bathroom.
- Firmly hold the swab **3–4cm** from the tip. **Avoid laying it down or touching its tip**.
- Find a comfortable position and insert the swab 2–3cm into your rectum.



 5–10 times in large circles against the inside of your rectum.



Gently rotate the swab whilst slowly removing it, and return to the tube pushing tightly to close the seal.
